

WELFARE OFFICER

Welfare Officers are required to join existing staff in providing 24-hour welfare support to military personnel and their families in hospitals in UK, Germany and Cyprus. The work includes regular out of hours attendance and weekend work on a rota basis. Applicants must also be prepared to move to different locations within the organization including areas of conflict, either scheduled or at short notice.

Applicants should be fit, responsible and flexible with a mature attitude. Successful candidates will have excellent verbal communication, interpersonal, written skills and a strong commitment to welfare provision. A recognized national and accredited health, welfare or social care qualification is essential, as is a full driving license. Proven welfare experience in a voluntary or professional capacity is desirable and an understanding of military life would be beneficial.

Corporate and on site induction training will be provided together with ongoing relevant Continuous Professional Development.

The starting salary is £19,621 plus on-call payments. Please note that this is a uniformed position and uniform will be provided.

The successful candidate will be subject to security vetting and enhanced CRB clearance prior to commencing position. The start date will be dependant on CRB and security vetting clearance.
